In addition to our regularly scheduled Saturday appointments, staff at the Detroit VA will be adding outpatient clinic appointments in a number of areas. These areas include Pain Management, Physical Therapy, Audiology, Eye Clinic, and several others.

Our ability to meet the health care needs of our Veterans remains a priority for the Detroit VA. Veterans who will be seen on Saturday have been contacted and appointments have been arranged.
